

Cable List for Courtrooms 1 and 4

To connect a computer to the PDS in courtroom 1

- 1 - VGA cable, HD-15 male (panel end) to HD-15 male (computer end)
- 1 - audio cable, stereo mini male (panel end) to male (computer end)

To connect a parallel device to the court computer in courtroom 4

The connection on the panel is a 25 pin female

To connect a SCSI device to the court computer in courtroom 4

The connection on the panel is a slim SCSI 2 MD50 pin female

To connect a computer to the PDS in courtroom 4

- 1 - VGA cable, HD-15 female (panel end) to HD-15 male (computer end)
- 1 - mouse cable adapter, PS/2 male (panel end) to PS/2 male (computer end)
- 1 - keyboard cable adapter, PS/2 male (panel end) to PS/2 male (computer end)
- 1 - audio cable, stereo mini male (panel end) to male (computer end)
- 1 - serial cable, DB9 male (panel end) to DB9 female (computer end)

In all cases listed above, the configuration for the computer end of the cable assumes industry standard connections on your computer. It is in your best interest to verify the connections on your computer to be sure that you arrive at the court with the correct cables. If you cannot locate a cable with the correct combination of male/female connections, a gender changer may be the solution.
